



Meals on Wheels, Etc. raises vital funds at second annual Giving Breakfast

Event highlights urgent need for senior services in Seminole County

SANFORD, Fla. (Sept. 23, 2025) — Meals on Wheels, Etc., a nonprofit organization dedicated to serving seniors in Seminole County for more than 50 years, is celebrating the success of its second annual Giving Breakfast.

The recent event, held at the Longwood Community Building, brought together community leaders, donors and sponsors in support of the nonprofit's mission to nourish, connect and care for older adults.

With nearly 150 attendees filling the venue, the Giving Breakfast exceeded expectations, raising more than \$51,000 in critical funds, with donations matched up to \$25,000 by a generous donor. These donations will directly benefit seniors in Seminole County by supporting home-delivered meals, neighborhood dining centers, transportation, home assistance, weatherization and more.



“The need in our community continues to grow, and so does the importance of raising the funds to meet it,” said Mike McKee, Executive Director of Meals on Wheels, Etc. “For many seniors, we are their lifeline. The support generated through this event will ensure we can continue providing not only nutritious meals, but also the care and companionship that so many rely on each day.”

The event featured inspiring stories from volunteers and seniors, a presentation from the Executive Director and a keynote speech from Director of Seminole County Emergency Management Alan Harris, who shared a heartfelt appeal to continue supporting Meals on Wheels Etc.'s mission.
